

**AIR FORCE ACQUISITION
MATERIEL POLICY REVIEW TEAM (MPRT) CHARTER**

15 October 1997

I. MISSION

- (1) Endorse publication of only value-added system acquisition directive documents.
- (2) Assist OPRs in preparing system acquisition directive documents.

II. PARTICIPANTS

SAF/AQX chairs the MPRT and evaluates the team's utility every year. SAF/AQXA and HQ AFMC/DRI are co-executive secretaries responsible for the administrative management of the MPRT and for recruiting, selecting and training team members from other organizations to accomplish the mission.

III. SCOPE

System Acquisition directive documents are those documents (doctrine documents, policy directives, instructions, operating instructions, manuals, and supplements) that directly impact the system management decision process and procedures for weapon systems and automated information systems.

Includes documents that impact:

1. Program management, acquisition logistics, contracting, engineering, financial management, test and evaluation.
2. System or support equipment development or modification

Does not include documents that impact:

1. Management, control, or disposition of fielded systems or equipment, spares requirement generation, procurement, or tracking.
2. Personnel management, development, or manpower resource management, transportation, supply, and ground safety.
