Just a note to confirm that the base facilities that were made available at no charge during the recent TALCE deployment to support Operation Phoenix Duke II will continue to be available at zero hrs notice for future missions.

All phone numbers and fax numbers currently allocated to the buildings will remain active and for U.S. Military use only. The vehicles supplied such as the 50 seat coaches, follow me truck, etc will also be available at no charge as required. The buildings themselves will remain out of use in readiness for future activity by the Military. This includes the entire first floor of the Air Traffic Tower, the movable buildings used by Port and Stage and the hangar area behind the tower that can store pallets, etc.

What I am basically saying is that with little or no notice of a mission or exercise I can have everything prepared. There will be no cost associated with this state of readiness as I believe it is in the long term interests of the airport to be as easy to use as possible.
