ADR Clause

H-027 Use of Alternate Disputes Resolution Processes

The agreement entitled "Overarching Principles Between The Department of The Air Force and Raytheon Company Inc. Concerning Use of Alternate Dispute Resolution Processes" signed by Raytheon Company Inc. and the U.S. Air Force on 16 Nov 98 and 1 Dec 98, respectively, is hereby incorporated herein by reference. The parties hereto agree to resolve all contractual issues in controversy at the Joint Primary Aircraft Training System program/contract execution level whenever possible, recognizing that the best knowledge of the issues involved is generally at the program level, and that resolution of problems at the contract execution level fosters teamwork in pursuing mutually satisfactory solutions. In the event that any such issues cannot be resolved at the program/contract execution level, then Alternate Dispute Resolution (ADR) procedures, as contemplated by FAR 32.214, shall be used to the maximum extent feasible to settle the dispute in lieu of litigation.
