**ATTENTION: INFORMATION REGARDING ACCESS TO FT BELVOIR**

The DAU Registrar's Office is sending this message to alert you to new access restrictions that will be in place at Fort Belvoir when you report to PMT 302, the Advanced Program Manager's Course (APMC), on September 10, 2001.

The Provost Marshall's Office at Fort Belvoir is still working out the details of this restricted access, which is taking effect worldwide on all U.S. military posts and bases. To remain as current as possible, check out <http://www.belvoir.army.mil> and click under the tab Vigilance, Preparedness, Protection.

Anyone who doesn't have a DoD vehicle sticker will have to get a visitor's pass in order to drive on to the post. Since most DAU students are associated with a military facility and already have a DoD vehicle sticker, we anticipate that the restrictions will affect a minority of students. If you are eligible for a DoD vehicle sticker at your current duty station and don't yet have one, we recommend that you get one before coming to Fort Belvoir.

For those of you who will require a visitor's pass:

- Get a day pass from the Provost Marshall's Visitor's Center
- DAU representatives will issue a visitor's pass to cover your attendance at APMC when you check in on campus at building 226, Scott Hall, on September 10
- Bring the following items to get an extended pass during check in:
  - Proof of insurance
  - Valid driver's license
  - Vehicle registration

TDY students: if you arrive before Monday, please refer to instructions at the Fort Belvoir web site for access to the post.

Industry students: have proof of course registration in case MPs manning the gates question your need to get on post.

You should also be aware that student parking will be at a premium on the first day of class, September 10, since most faculty/staff parking inside the DAU/DSMC campus quadrangle will be occupied by Acquisition and Logistics Reform Week displays. Get here early and car pool if possible.
